City & Guilds units:

What else could I do on the programme

The Edexcel National Test for Literacy and Numeracy will be offered at Level 1 or 2. If you have not received a Literacy or Numeracy qualification or equivalent above Level 1 in the last five years then this will be a compulsory part of your course.

How is the learning Marked/Assessed?

Portfolio building, assignment, online tests throughout and a final online test for CISCO and one for City and Guilds (see notes above).

What can I do next?

ELATT is planning to run one Level 3 course each year. Places are limited and progression is dependant on attendance and achievement at level 2. Alternatively we will be happy to assist you with information about other level 3 providers. Ideally you should be able to get a job with our level 2 provision if you successfully complete the course.
